





The Big Sit!® had another great year in 2022. We saw the number of circles increase to 119, up from 92 in 2021. It was great to see people returning or starting new circles. Although the New Haven Bird Club is a small nonprofit organization of all volunteers, we feel strongly that The Big Sit!® tradition should continue. Many circles are used for fundraising, with funds going to conservation. The Big Sit! has also become a part of the birding culture. We are happy that you all are participating!

We are listing the circle results by species only, as determined by eBird. If a circle reported a subspecies or a hybrid, those birds are counted by eBird as "other taxa" and not species.

The Big Sit! circle at Cape May, New Jersey, was new this year and soared high with 152 species after 24 hours of work. They did a great job to achieve overall winner of "bragging rights" for this year!

The second-place finisher for number of species was Smith Neck Road in Connecticut, which produced a strong effort with 104 species.

We understand there are locations that simply have a greater abundance of birds, and the Big Sit! is about having fun as well as trying to see the greatest number of species. We hope you had fun. We did.

The Golden Bird Award: This year the New Haven Bird Club was able to reintroduce the Golden Bird Award. Zeiss Optics donated a pair of Zeiss Conquest HD 8x42 binoculars to the winner. The award involves a double drawing; first, a species is randomly drawn from all of the species observed during the Big Sit! This year the Scissor-tailed Flycatcher was drawn as the Golden Bird. Next, a winner is randomly drawn from all of the circles that recorded the Golden Bird. From a list of eight circles reporting the Scissor-tailed Flycatcher, the winner was the circle at the Eagle Cove Observation Platform, Tishomingo NWR, sponsored by Texoma Audubon. Congratulations to the winner, and special thanks to Zeiss Optics for sponsoring The Golden Bird Award.



Many circles were held on public lands: National Wildlife Refuges, Nature Preserves, and Wildlife Sanctuaries. It is important to point out how critical these lands are in bird migration. The birds certainly bring us to beautiful places.

The Big Sit! 2022 Summary:

This year The Big Sit! had four countries participating: Australia (1 circle), Costa Rica (1 Circle), Guatemala (1 circle), and the United States of America (116 circles). Hopefully in the future we can increase the number of circles and attract Big Sit! circles in other countries and on other continents.

Number of Circles in 2022: 119 (includes circles that reported on both days); (92 circles in 2021; 102 circles in 2020)

The Best Overall Count (most species identified by a single circle): Cape May Cape Island Hawkwatch Platform reported 152 species. (In 2021 there was a tie between Smith Neck Rd, Old Lyme CT, and Big Sit Zeiss Birding Team, Segerstads fyr Sweden, each with 97 species.)

Longest Duration of a Circle: Tie with 24 hours: Cape May NJ Cape Island Hawkwatch Platform, and Shaver's Creek Env. Center—Boardwalk Huntingdon PA. (In 2021 Shavers Creek, Huntington, Pennsylvania USA: 22 hours and 45 min)

The Big Sit! Total Number of Species Reported: 495 species and 75 taxa (573 species in 2021, 472 species in 2020)

The Big Sit! Total Number of Birds Reported: 113,714 (535,767 in 2021; 194,484 in 2020). Note that some circles report "X" instead of numbers.

For Next Year: We still need to iron out some issues with eBird: problems with leaving a checklist open for an extended period of time; using trip reports; and using and submitting periodic checklists throughout the day, to name a few. Also, our Facebook page needs adjustment so that anyone can post pictures.

Comments: The following are some comments made on the eBird Checklists. They give a nice snapshot of the weather, some wildfires, long days birding, and other unique observations.

<u>Sussex County Delaware</u> - A beautiful sunny day with slight NNE wind brought raptors across the bay from Cape May on migration. We braved the cool day and sustained our enthusiasm with coffee and bagels.

<u>Birdnerds in Lancaster Nebraska</u>- 36 people came to help throughout the day; not all stayed to help all 8 hours.

<u>Thompson Wildlife Sanctuary Carroll County NH</u> - 6th annual Big Sit at NH Audubon's Alice Bemis Thompson Wildlife Sanctuary. This year's event was characterized by good numbers of certain birds (Am. Robin, Myrtle Warblers), some raptor diversity, but an overall low diversity (e.g. no shorebirds, waders, blackbirds, etc.) led to a very low species count compared to previous years when we've had between 48 and 58 species.

<u>Sarasota Florida - Sarasota Audubon Society</u> - The Big Sit "Celery Fields Forever" team observed/recorded sightings in three shifts from 7 am until 7 pm at Palmer Blvd.

<u>Estero Llano Grande State Park Texas</u> - Weslaco Red-Crowns, Captain started from 6 am to 7:30 pm, 13.5 hours. The count started at 70 degrees, with a high of 88 at 3pm, no precipitation with partly cloudy skies. The winds were calm to begin but up to 12 mph later in the day. An even 50 hours of time were spent cumulatively among eleven birders.

<u>Harrison Michigan</u> - This is the Big Sit location for the "Metro Munchers" within Lake St. Clair Metropark overlooking Point Rosa Marsh. The weather was windy all day, with sunny conditions most of the day, then cloudy later in the afternoon.

Eaton Pond and Marsh Carroll County New Hampshire - BIG SIT. "Eaton and Birdin." Our THIRD Big Sit at this location on our property. Participants George and Andrea Robbins. Started at 5:45 AM, ended 1:05 PM. Was 30 degrees when we started, with frost on the vegetation. End temp 55. Our scopes were badly fogged over until 9 AM. Was a bit breezy early, and maybe too cold for owls. But, we eventually heard three Barred Owls after 6 AM. Skies were sunny at dawn, then went cloudy until late morning. Eventually the dark clouds moved off, to bright blue skies with passing white clouds. Wind was variable. Clouds were moving from the west, but wind gusts were often from the South. We had some nice finches, but it was pretty windy from 8-11 so little was flying during that time, There really wasn't any noticeable hawk migration, just a few hawks moving around. New high of 48 species (old was 45). We learned to take seat cushions for the lawn chairs.....much warmer.

<u>Milford Connecticut</u>- Sunday. Started just before 4:30 with P, F M, and J. Winds light west moving quickly to NW. Full moon with Jupiter beside it. Dropping down in the west. High was 12:30 a.m. T M showed at 5:30 with coffee, and G at 5:40. About 20 species by 6:20 a.m. at first light. 23 by 6:30 first light enough to see.

<u>Wharton Point, Brunswick Maine</u> - The Big Sit! - Merrymeeting Audubon Field Trip/Maquoit Bay Birders. Circle centered on the Wharton Point monument rock overlooking Maquoit Bay. Clear/sunny to some clouds later in the afternoon, calm winds early to southwesterly winds 15-20 mph in the afternoon, temperature 31° - 58°. 11th annual The Big Sit! at Wharton Point. Thanks to all who participated and made this The Big Sit! one of the best ever.

<u>John Heinz NWR Philadelphia County Pennsylvania</u> - BIG SIT at Heinz Refuge, at top deck of Observation Tower. Arrived at tower a few minutes after 5am. Ended at 6:40 pm. Fantastic day with about 75 friends and visitors, and beautiful weather. Tally 83 species - second highest total ever (tough to beat record of 88 species in 2014). Many thanks to all who came out this year!

<u>Escuintla, Guatemala</u>- OUR BIG SIT 2022 at The Lost Tinamou! Rain on and off in the morning, afternoon overcast and rainy... Lots of fun at home!

<u>Alajuela Costa Rica</u> - The circle is located in on a piece of property located in Cajon arriba de Grecia, Alajuela Province in Costa Rica on a street called Calle Matapalo. It is on the Costa Rica Pacific slope at about 4,500 meters.

Circle Description: Our circle is very unique in that it encompasses an outdoor patio but also extends into the apartment so that we can continue to bird from inside while remaining in the circle. That location allows us to easily come and go from the circle throughout the 24 hour period which makes it a bit difficult to track the effort but at the same time makes participating in the Big Sit very comfortable and manageable.

Lake Waxahachie, Ellis Texas - This was our ninth Big Sit at the shallow west end of Lake Waxahachie. This year the lake was the lowest it's been for our Big Sit, with the shorebirds being quite far out. Despite the ample mud, shorebird diversity was low, with only five species. We had continuous NE winds all day, which caused a raptor flight early throughout the morning, rather than in the afternoon. We had thirteen species of raptors, with Peregrine Falcon being the only other "expected" raptor missing. Probably our most "unusual" or "best" bird was Caracara, which was seen briefly by only a few participants and was new for the count.

<u>Skagit Washington</u> - Skagit Audubon's Big Sit event. Located at the Y on the dike at the WDFW Skagit Wildlife Area, Headquarters Unit. Not all of the people in the party stayed for the whole time. Most stayed for about two hours. Weather was mostly clear with light smoke haze at times. Temps low '70's for the afternoon.

<u>Discovery Park Seattle Washington</u>- THE BIG SIT, 2022 "South Meadowlarks, 14th Annual" (in Seattle's Discovery Park) N.B. this day began with FOG, and throughout was challenging due to HAZE from wildfires (slight yellow-orange tint cast upon all views, and photos)

Brooklyn New York - Merlin wouldn't find the mourning dove or nighthawk when trying to identify.

<u>Needville Texas</u> - Performed a "Big Sit" from the 3-story observation tower on the north side of 40 acre lake at Brazos Bend State Park in Fort Bend County.

<u>Pondicherry NWR, Jefferson New Hampshire</u> - BIG SIT. Temperature 36 at start rising to 47 with the passage of a cold front and a west wind 5 mph and clearing. Light rain for first two hours and low cloud cover. No migration due to west winds.
